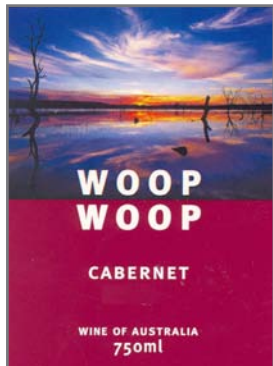

## Woop Woop Cabernet 2007

South Australia



### Winery Background

Woop Woop is a collaboration between Ben Riggs, the winemaker of Penny's Hill, and Tony Parkinson, owner of Penny's Hill. The winery strives to provide rich, ripe wines chock full of Aussie character at an affordable price.

Woop Woop is Australian slang for the middle of nowhere in the Outback...what we would call the boonies, as in, "just been to Woop Woop and back."

### Winemaking

Following fermentation in temperature controlled, stainless steel tanks, the wine spends several months in French and American oak.

### Viticulture

Made from 100% Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from key growing regions in S. Australia. 40% comes from McLaren Vale, 54% comes from Langhorne Creek with the balance coming from other areas of the Fleurieu Peninsula.

### Analytical

*Grapes:* 100% Cabernet from South Australia including 54% Langhorne Creek & 40% McLaren Vale

*Yields:* 4-5 tons/acre

*Aging:* French & American oak

*Vintage:* Winemaker reports are positive on the quality of the 2007 vintage despite the challenging growing conditions. Dry and hot conditions early in the new-year resulted in an early start to vintage – three weeks earlier than 2006. Some relief from the dry conditions came with rains in January. As a result, some fruit split but the rain refreshed the majority of growers. No further rain interrupted harvest and weather conditions in March were ideal.

*Alc/Vol:* 15.0%

### Press
